All students must register each year by returning the required forms and the registration fee.

FEES (Please make all checks out to the Notre Dame Regional School System.)

REGISTRATION FEE	\$200 per student is due with the registration forms. Maximum: \$500. >The \$100 discount per student during early re-registration ends February 16, 2012.
FUNDRAISING FEE	\$500 per family with students in grades K - 12 *
SERVICE HOUR FEE	\$5/hour fee will be charged to families who choose not to participate.
GRADUATION FEE	\$125 per 12 th grade student
ACTIVITY FEES	Varies.

TUITION RATES

For grades K through 12 only –	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All of the parishes in the Diocese of Scranton provide a subsidy for our Catholic Schools. Families active in their parish can benefit from this support by paying a reduced tuition rate. In order to receive the Catholic tuition rate, a family must have a Pastor Verification form signed by their pastor. The Second and Third-child Discount applies to all children (K-12) in a single family that attend any school in the NDRSS, with the oldest child being the first child. The tuition for the fourth or additional children will be free.

TUITION PAYMENT PLANS – Specify your choice by checking the appropriate plan on your tuition contract.

- Payment due in full by August 1, 2012. Accounts paid in full earn the early payment discount of \$100.
- ACH payments through the FACTS Tuition Management can be scheduled on the 5th or 20th of the month
 - Two payments: August and January
 - Ten payments: July through April
 FACTS re-enrollment is automatic unless the school is instructed by you to cancel the agreement. The FACTS enrollment fee is the family’s responsibility.
- Credit card payments. Contact the business office to arrange a two or ten month payment schedule. There is a 3% processing fee on all credit card payments.

Families are required to keep up with their payment schedule and contact the business office if there is any deviation. Requests to extend the number of payments must be approved by your principal. All payments must be complete by June 20, 2013.

***FUNDRAISING FEE-** Specify your choice by checking the appropriate option on your tuition contract.

The fundraising fee requirement per family is \$500.

The Notre Dame Regional School System offers a Winner’s Circle Raffle that provides families an option to sell tickets to meet their requirement. A minimum number of tickets, with a total value of \$600, are required.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

The Diocese of Scranton has arranged for tuition assistance based on need through the Educational Improvement Tax Credit Scholarship program. Notre Dame Regional School System, through generous donations, also provides assistance to some of our neediest families. - Applications should be postmarked by April 16, 2012. Those mailed after April 16th will still be processed, but are not guaranteed to be included in the initial EITC award allocation.
- If your registration is complete, please request a Verification of Registration form from the business office to be submitted to PSAS with your form in lieu of payment.
- The Private School Aid Service (PSAS) application must be completed to be considered for tuition assistance.
