

## Dress Code for Homecoming Dance, Friday October 7<sup>th</sup> 7-10PM

The Homecoming dance is a dress-up dance. Students in grades 7-12 may attend; the cost is \$5, payable at the door. Students in grades 9-12 may bring a guest. All guests must be signed up in homeroom by Thursday, October 6<sup>th</sup>. Students and their guests are expected to dress nicely in accordance with Notre Dame's school standards. The following dress code must be obeyed. Students are responsible for their guests and are expected to spend the evening with their guests.

### Boys

- 1) Collared shirts or turtlenecks or sweaters.
- 2) Dress slacks.
- 3) Dress shoes or dress boots.
- 4) Jackets and ties are optional.

### Girls

- 1) Dress, skirt and blouse or dress slacks and blouse.
- 2) Dress shoes or dress boots.

All ND students and their guests must abide by the following standards:

- 1) No flip-flops or athletic sandals.
- 2) No midriffs or belly shirts.
- 3) No shorts or low rise pants.
- 4) No exposed flesh between the waistband and the bottom of the shirt at any time.
- 5) No halters, bare backs or indiscreet necklines. All shirts, blouses or dresses must have **2 straps**.
- 6) No muscle shirts.
- 7) No visible boxers or other undergarments.
- 8) No excessively short dresses or skirts.
- 9) No jeans, sweats, pajama pants or athletic wear.
- 10) No visible tattoos.
- 11) No clothing that violates Notre Dame's standards. If you are unsure as to what this means, ask Ms. Brown ahead of time.
